Have a Cigna coverage question?

Sharona Ferguson, MNPS's new dedicated Cigna representative, has the answer! She's worked at Cigna for six years and comes equipped with a vast knowledge of benefits and claims.

FYB asked Sharona to describe what's special about the services she provides MNPS retirees. Two things stand out: personal interaction and her problem-solving abilities.

In one example, a retiree had switched medical plans. Because his coverage was temporarily in flux, he was having trouble getting his medication refilled. At 6 p.m. on a Friday, when the issue was still not resolved, Sharona knew she couldn't wait until Monday to find a solution.

"He needed his medication," she says.
"He couldn't go through the weekend without it."

So, she set an alarm. When it went off early Saturday morning, she got to work, going back and forth on the phone with the pharmacy until the prescription finally went through.

Sharona also has a team of Cigna service coordinators at the ready. If someone asks a question she can't answer or presents a problem she can't resolve herself, she'll call on a service coordinator. But she's happy to be the first point of contact for retirees.

"I want them to know my cell phone is secure," she says. "They can shoot me a text message anytime."

Sharona lives in Cleveland (Tennessee, not Ohio) and enjoys traveling, shopping and teaching her five-year-old daughter the secrets to providing great customer service. Because she works from home, her daughter often gets to see her mom in action.

What you can earn

You can receive **\$30** just for getting your Yearly Health Check-up. Once you complete that, you can earn these additional rewards:



Mammogram	\$25
Two diabetes management appointments	\$30
Colorectal screening	\$30
Bone density screening	\$25
Immunization (flu, COVID or pneumonia)	\$10
Community engagement (volunteering, group classes, etc.)	\$10
Online engagement (registering for and using myCigna.com)	Up to \$20
Getting active with Silver&Fit (fitness center, health coaching, etc.)	Up to \$50

Medicare Advantage enrollees can earn up to \$200/person.

How to spend your rewards

You can use your Cigna Healthy Today card to purchase health-related items in-store at more than 62,000 participating retail locations. You can also use it to purchase over-the-counter, health-related items online at **CignaHealthyToday.com**. The card can't be used at retailers' websites or apps.

To check your Cigna Healthy Today card balance, view your transaction history, search covered items, find preferred retailers or shop online, go to **CignaHealthyToday.com** or log on to **myCigna.com**.



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Simply put, Cigna and MNPS want to encourage and reward healthy behaviors. This lowers costs for both you and Cigna and, most importantly, can help catch health issues early, when they're easier to treat.



Cigna benefits

Q: How does Cigna's worldwide coverage work? How do I find a doctor overseas?

A: If you're planning to travel overseas, it's good to know that:

- Your Cigna plan covers emergency and urgent care at 100%, up to a benefit maximum of \$50,000, after you pay a \$100 copay.
 - » If you have a medical emergency while traveling outside the U.S., you should seek care at the closest appropriate health care facility. The plan pays at the in-network level, regardless of where the service is provided.
 - » The provider may ask you to pay at the time of service. If so, you'll need to submit a claim to the address provided in your Cigna customer handbook. Cigna will process the claim and reimburse you at the in-network level.
- Cigna will NOT cover routine or elective care received while traveling outside the U.S.
- Medicare Part D plans will not cover drugs purchased outside the U.S. and its territories.

Q: I got a phone call from a company offering to do a prescription drug check-up. They mentioned that they work with Cigna. How do I know it's not a scam?

A: You might get a call from Cigna or an affiliated company (like Alegis) for one of several reasons. For example, you may get a call to:

- Schedule a home health visit
- Return your call
- Let you know about a coaching program that could benefit you
- Tell you that you qualify for Cigna's Case Management program
- Ask for additional information if you recently received health care services or will need them soon

We understand you can't be too careful these days. If you're ever concerned about a call or voicemail you receive, simply call Cigna Customer Service at

1-888-281-7867.

Q: Is my dental coverage now under my Cigna retiree medical plan?

A: No. When MNPS switched from Delta Dental to Cigna as its dental insurance vendor in 2022, it caused some confusion.

Your dental coverage continues to be a separate, standalone dental plan.
You can access your dental benefits and claims by visiting myCigna.com or calling 1-800-244-6224.

Tip: Always present your Cigna dental ID card when seeing a dental provider.





A: We get that question a lot.

The MNPS Health Care Centers do offer telehealth visits for many common health concerns, such as:

- Stomach viruses, rashes and chronic conditions like allergies and insomnia
- Follow-up visits if labs are not needed
- Some physical therapy visits
- Medication management with our behavioral health providers
- Health coaching with our onsite coaches

Because some concerns require testing and/or lab work, not all visits are appropriate for telehealth.

If you have a regular provider at any of our five clinics, you may be able to make a telehealth appointment with that provider. We suggest you connect with your provider through the patient portal or call us to ask if a telehealth visit is appropriate for your need.



If you're enrolled in the Cigna Medicare Advantage PPO or HMO:

Your hearing benefit is provided through Hearing Care Solutions. It covers:

- One routine hearing exam per year for \$0 copay
- A hearing aid benefit of up to \$1,400 every 3 years (\$0 copay for fitting)

If you're enrolled in the Cigna Medicare Surround Plan:

Your hearing benefit is provided through Amplifon. It covers:
